## CONSERVATION VOTERS ENDORSE BOB ODELL FOR STATE SENATE

**New London, NH...** The Granite State Conservation Voters Alliance today endorsed Bob Odell for re-election to the New Hampshire State Senate. The group made it's endorsement at a meet the candidates breakfast event here in New London.

"We are honored and proud to endorse Bob Odell for another term in the State Senate," said Jim O'Brien, GSCVA Executive Director. "Bob has become a leader in the Senate on conservation issues, sponsoring numerous pieces of legislation that would protect our environment - including increasing funding for land protection and legislation signed into law by Governor Lynch that will reduce mercury pollution."

Bob Odell earned an 88% rating for his environmental voting record by GSCVA on it's Environmental Scorecard – among the highest scores in the Senate, and the highest rating among the sixteen Republicans in that body.

"Bob's rating shows that he has made the protection of New Hampshire's environment a priority in the Senate," continued O'Brien. "Voters in District 8 who are concerned about our natural resources and quality of life should know that Senator Odell consistently votes to protect our environment. NH's environment needs more leaders like Bob Odell.
